

Flower of the flock USJ classifies new species of Lebanese flora

The Faculty of Science at **Universite Saint-Joseph** classified a new genus of Lebanese flora, the university announced this week. *Astartoseris triquetra*'s name is derived from the Phoenician god of war and fertility and can be found on the rocky cliffs of Hamat near Seydet el Nouriyeh. The newly discovered flower is an endangered species.
